BEWARE of malicious apps



Scammers are tricking victims into downloading malicious apps to steal their money. How can you tell if your phone has been infected with malware?

Some Tell-Tale Signs



Excessive and unexplained data use



Random pop-ups or new apps not installed by you



Noticeably slower responses or performance



Battery drains unusually quickly

What Should You Do?



Turn your phone to 'flight mode'. Check that Wi-Fi is switched off and do not switch it on



Review the apps installed, remove unknown or suspicious apps



Deep-scan your phone with an updated anti-virus app



Use a different and trusted device to check for any unauthorised banking or CPF transactions

- As further precautions, consider doing a "factory reset" of your phone, change passwords of all accounts and enable multi-factor authentication.
